INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

Abstract submissions are invited for the Cuticon Rajasthan. Please send your abstracts to rajcuticon2025@gmail.com. Conference registration is mandatory for all submissions.

Abstracts can be submitted in three categories: Award Paper, Free Paper, and E-Poster, and should be based on Case Reports/Case Series or Original Research.

While all delegates are welcome to present, priority for paper presentations will be given to original research studies. Each with only one eligible for oral presentatives.

The submission deadline is 30th September 2025.

ABSTRACT PREPARATION GUIDELINES:

Abstracts must be submitted in English, using Times New Roman font, size 14, and double-spaced. Do not include identifying information in the abstract; author details and affiliations should be submitted in another word document in the same email. Keep abstracts under 250 words.

Submissions must be original, unpublished, and not previously presented. Avoid including keywords, graphs, figures, tables, or references.

A conflict of interest statement is mandatory. Once submitted, abstracts cannot be edited.

If selected, presenters will be recognized, but no financial support will be provided.

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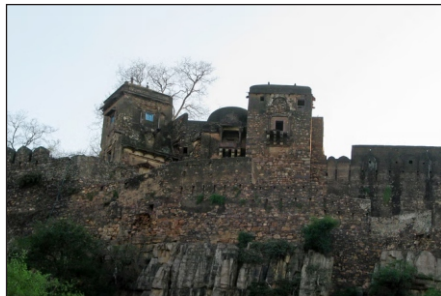
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RANTHAMBORE TOURISM & NEARBY ATTRACTIONS

RANTHAMBORE FORT

Rajasthan is one of the most historically significant places in India, and there are several forts, such as the Ranthambore Fort, that bear testimony to their glorious rule. In fact, Ranthambore Fort is one of the oldest, most magnificent and most representative forts made by the Rajputs in all of Rajasthan. Built during the 12th century by the royal Chauhan family, this fort is also a World Heritage Site, as declared by UNESCO. If you want to experience the true essence and history of Rajasthan, you must visit Ranthambore and the Fort that is the city's crowning glory.



TRINETRA GANESH TEMPLE

The Trinetra Ganesh Temple is one of the oldest temples in India, built with red Karauli stone. It is situated inside the premises of the Ranthambore Fort, which is one of the most famous tourist attractions in all of Rajasthan. This temple is a one-of-a-kind temple, where Lord Ganesha is represented with all the members of his family. Visit Trinetra Ganesh Temple on enriching Rajasthan tour packages. In Hindu mythology, Lord Ganesha is considered to be the powerful God of wealth, fortune, wisdom and education.



JOGI MAHAL

Jogi Mahal is referred to as one of the places in Rajasthan where tigers used to rule. This is because of its close proximity to the hub of tigers - Ranthambore National Park. The Mahal is located at a distance of 500 meters from the Ranthambore Fort. It is considered as one of the oldest heritage buildings in expanse of Ranthambore. The Mahal made its way as a hunting resort for the royal families. The royal family used to spend some time at the Jogi Mahal in the course of their hunting expedition to the nearby forests of Ranthambore.



RANTHAMBORE TOURISM & NEARBY ATTRACTIONS

Rajiv Gandhi Regional Museum of Natural History

It helps to understand the diversity of earth as well. There are three floors in the museum but the visitors have access only to the ground floor where 'Biodiversity of Rajasthan or Forests and Wildlife of Rajasthan' are mainly exhibited. The facsimile of animals such as chinkara (gazelle), leopard, lion, and tiger are the main attractions along with the collection of village dioramas of the Bishnoi community and Rajasthan rural area.



THE RANTHAMBORE SCHOOL OF ART SOCIETY

The school has artists from the adjacent villages. The students from the school visit the National Park to spread their thoughts of preserving natural biodiversity. The school has watercolor paintings, charcoal, poster color painting on silk, and black and white sketches as well. The paintings will be placed on famous exhibitions through which amazing thoughts are being transferred to the public.



RANTHAMBORE NATIONAL PARK

Tourists love to visit this national park in Ranthambore to head out on jungle safaris into the dense forest. In addition to this, you can enjoy various other adventures here too including nature walks through the lush green forest trails and bird watching tours to various important hotspots.
